Draft NVIC 05-17 Summary

- Maritime industry uses cyber technologies for communications, access control, other integrated control systems.
- NVIC will provide guidance, recommended practices for MTSA facilities to address cyber vulnerabilities.
 - Enclosure 1 discusses existing MTSA regulatory requirements applicable to cyber security.
 - Enclosure 2 provides a more detailed set of recommendations based on the NIST Framework for preventing and mitigating cybersecurity threats.

TWIC Reader Rule

FINAL RULE:

- Published in Federal Register on August 23, 2016
- 2 Year implementation from date of publication

APPLICABILITY:

- Requires higher risk MTSA regulated vessels/facilities (Risk Group A) to conduct electronic TWIC inspections for access to secure areas, or upon boarding a vessel.

ISSUES:

- Different "bulk or in bulk" definition between NPRM and TWIC Reader Rule
- Unintended consequences of Final Rule





TWIC Reader Rule – Petition for Rulemaking

MAY 15, 2017:

 USCG receives petition for rulemaking regarding TWIC Reader Rule

MAY 18, 2017:

- USCG publishes petition on Regulations.Gov [DOCKET ID: USCG-2017-0447]

JULY 2017:

- USCG continuing to consider all options regarding best path forward to address petition and clarify/correct Reader Rule.
