Visa Entry Requirements

- Citizens from over 90 countries, including the U.S., Canada, Australia and all EU member nations, can visit Chile without a visa for up to 90 days
- A current and valid passport must be presented at immigration control
- Citizens of certain South American countries can travel with ID card
- Australian citizens must pay a reciprocity tax of U\$ 117 upon arrival

- Valparaíso is about 60 miles (92 km) away from the Santiago Airport
