- **Direct flights daily from Atlanta, Dallas, Houston, Los Angeles, Miami, New York and Toronto**

# Visa Entry Requirements

- **Citizens from over 90 countries, including the U.S., Canada, Australia and all EU member nations, can visit Chile without a visa for up to 90 days**
- **A current and valid passport must be presented at immigration control**
- **Citizens of certain South American countries can travel with ID card**
- **Australian citizens must pay a reciprocity tax of U\$ 117 upon arrival**

# Getting to Valparaíso

- **Valparaíso is about 60 miles (92 km) away from the Santiago Airport**
- **Convention organizers will be providing free ground transportation to Valparaíso at pre-scheduled times**

**Background**

**World Heritage Site**

The city of Valparaíso was declared a world heritage site by UNESCO in 2003. Decision motivated by the historical value of its architecture and emblematic port. The city reflects the urban development of Latin America during the 1800s. Buildings highlighted by UNESCO include the Chilean Navy building and the La Matriz Church.

By the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the Valparaíso port was the most commercial one on the western coasts of the South Pacific. It promoted the development of the South American trade as well as the arrival of influences from different parts of the world, which could be considered as a testimony of the beginnings of globalization. Today, the port has also allowed the arrival of tourist cruises.

**Casablanca Valley**

Comparted by beautiful vineyards and wineries, Casablanca Valley is situated on the coastal plain between Santiago and Valparaíso. It has gained international prestige for the production of quality white and red wines. Most notably, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir.

The Casablanca Valley and Valparaíso are recognized as a world capital of wine by the Great Wine Capitals Global Network.

**Transportation**

- Trolleybuses – Used since 1952, it is the second oldest trolleybus system in South America.
- Cable Car/Funicular – First built in 1883 to commute between the city and hills within minutes.

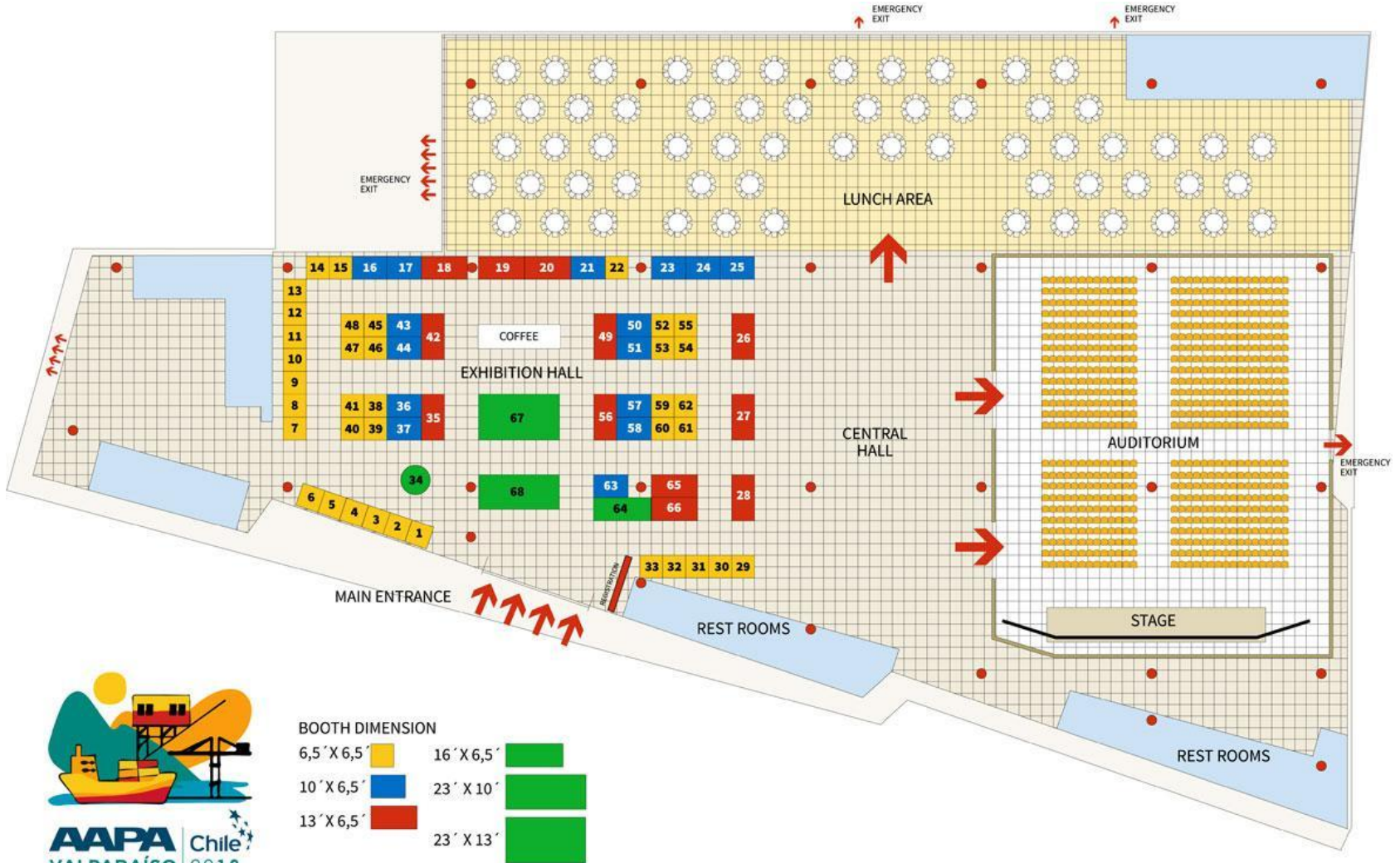
