




Floating trash in Baltimore Harbor is a major problem.







Step 1

solar-powered
conveyor.

Step 2
The conveyor drops trash into a dumpster inside the canopy.

Step 3
The full dumpster is barged to the City's waste-to-energy plant.








Trash Reduction Program
