



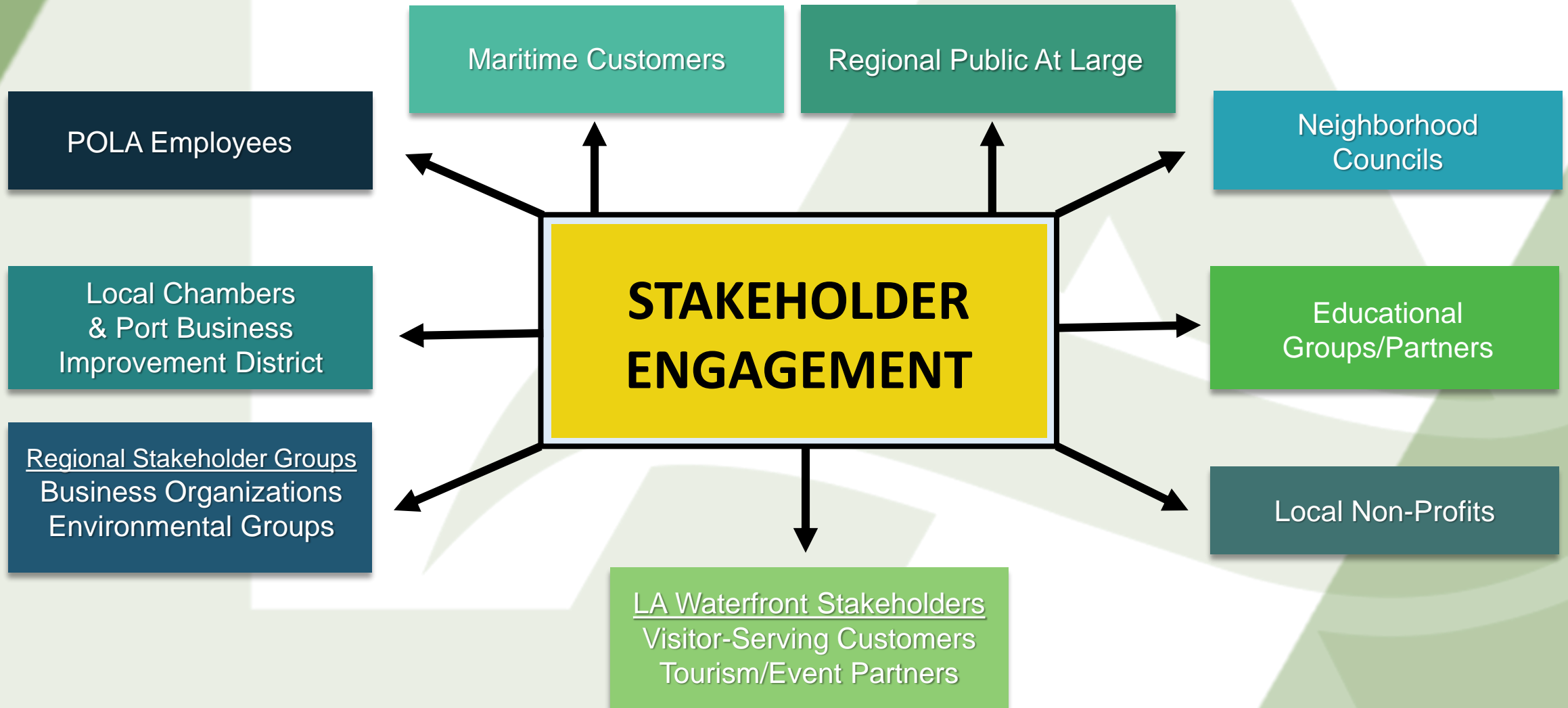

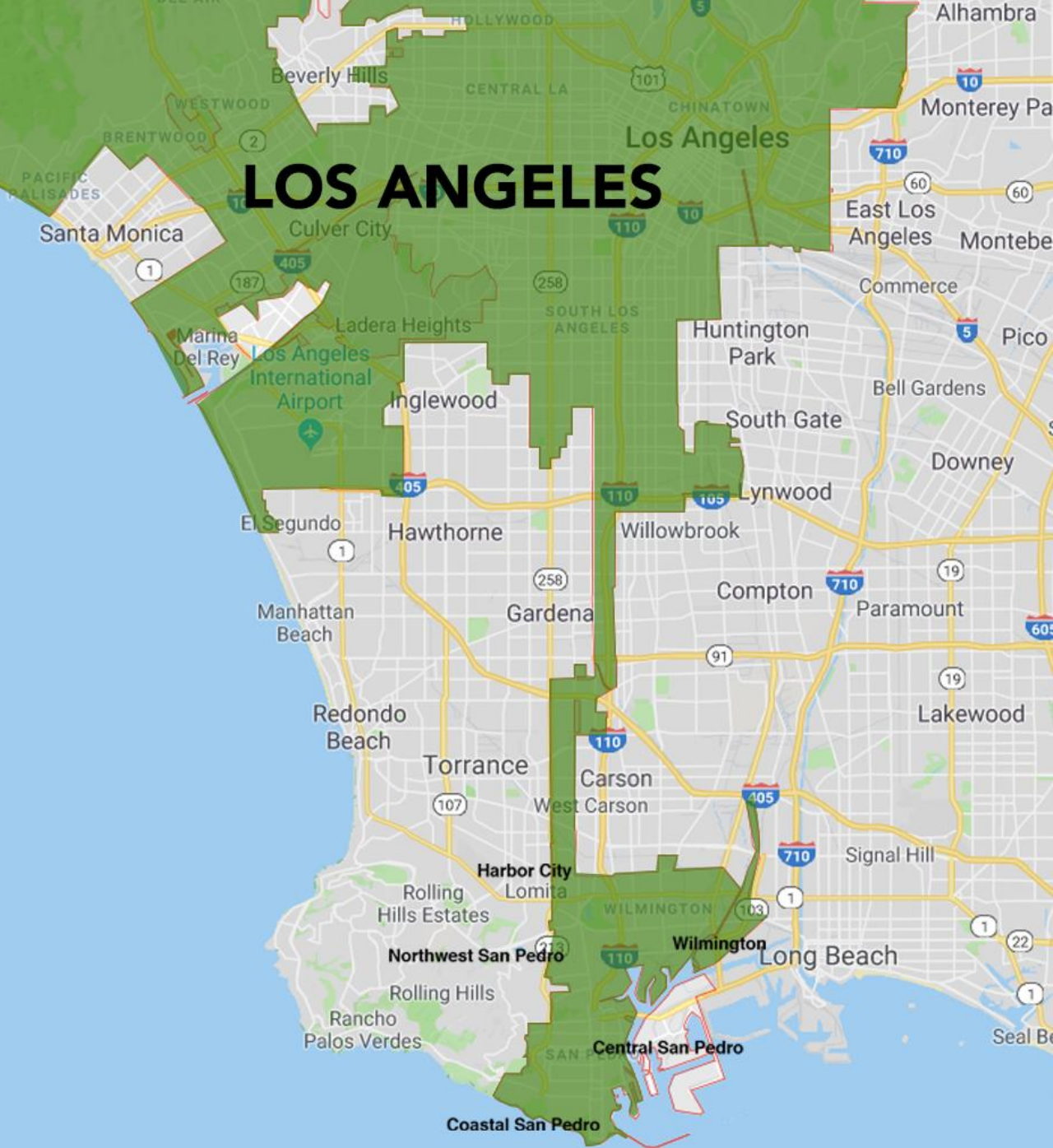

OUR STAKEHOLDER LANDSCAPE



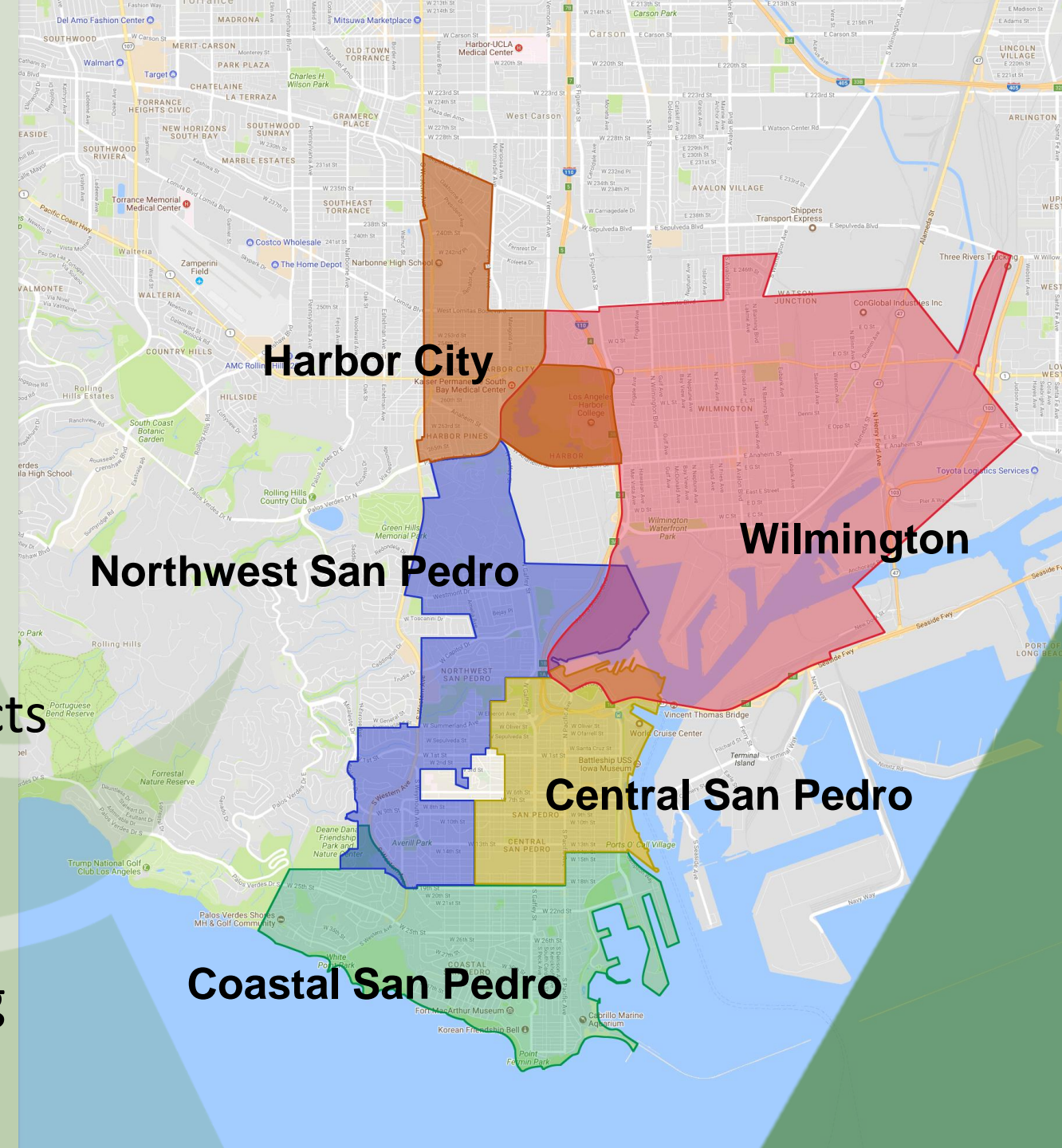


Los Angeles Metro Area

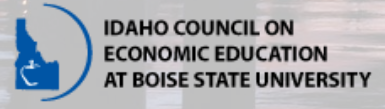

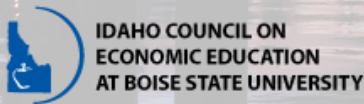
