


Port of New York and New Jersey

Port of New York and New Jersey (PONYNJ) is the largest Port on the East Coast.

3rd largest port in the nation behind Port of Los Angeles and Port of Long Beach in California.





Helping the Regional Economy

The economic impacts generated by the port include:

- 229,000 direct jobs.
- 400,000 total jobs in the Region.
- More than \$25.7B in personal income.
- More than \$64.8B in business income.
- Close to \$8.5B in federal, state, and local tax revenues.

Provides oversight on implementation of programs and initiatives that will improve productivity and services of the Port of NY & NJ






WDIT Subcommittees
