Port Security Grant Program

- On average, Congress has been funding the PSGP at \$100 million per year; and
- Typical Split of PSGP Funding is 25% Ports; 60% Public Entities; 15% Private
- AAPA Priorities Are Increased Funding, More Direct Funding To Port Authorities
- AAPA is calling for \$4 billion in port security investments over the next decade or \$400 million annually
