

Background – EPA-Port NOLA Trash Free Waters Pilot

- 2014 - EPA selected the Port of New Orleans as one of several projects to address trash and debris impacting waterways
- Dec-March 2015 - Port hosted three 5-hour meetings with regional stakeholders
- March - the Board of Commissioners adopted a port policy committing to goals developed in TFW
- April – Approval by Port's C.O.O. for Port to lead/facilitate storm drain mural project as part of TFW commitments







Clarence Henry Truckway Drain and Parameters




- Mural perimeter limits available to paint (red square):
 - 4 feet towards river
 - 4 feet left & right
 - 2 feet towards roadway
- May extend elements outside of this boundary, but must be approved and present in proposed artwork
- Grate may be painted, however may be replaced in upcoming grate replacement project



Erato Cruise Drain and Parameters



3 foot grid overlay



- Mural size
 - Must be at least 3 feet around the drain (approx. yellow line)
 - Maximum solid coverage of 6 feet around the drain (approx. blue line)
- Elements of the artwork may extend outside of this boundary, but must be approved and present in proposed artwork
- Grate and pillars may be painted
