

- As an idea to take exercises further








If you haven't figured it out

Tabletop Exercise

Game

Drills

Functional Exercises

Full Scale Exercises



Tabletop Exercise

- Practicing group problem solving
- Familiarizing senior officials
- Conducting a specific case study
- Examining personnel contingencies
- Testing group message interpretation
- Participating in information sharing
- Assessing interagency coordination
- Achieving limited or specific objectives



Game

- Gaining policy or process consensus
- Conducting "what-if" analyses of existing plans
- Developing new plans



Drills

- A narrow focus, measured against established standards
- Instant feedback
- Realistic environment
- Performance in isolation



Functional Exercise

- Evaluating Functions
- Evaluating Emergency Operations Centers, headquarters, and staff
- Reinforcing established policies and procedures
- Measuring the adequacy of resources
- Examining interjurisdictional relationships



Full-Scale Exercises

- Assess organizational and individual performance
- Demonstrating interagency cooperation
- Allocating resources and personnel
- Assessing equipment capabilities
- Activating personnel and equipment
- Assessing interjurisdictional cooperation
- Exercising public information systems
- Testing communication systems and procedures
- Analyzing plans, policies, procedures, etc.



Why ICS?

Presidential Directive
Everyone else is doing it
Sounded like a good idea
It worked for oil





Seriously

Provides common language Clear lines of Authority

What do you want to accomplish

Provides focus

Refined throughout design process

Planning

Realistic Scenario

- Have Player "buy-in"
- Sets tone for entire exercise

Identify Players

Who would participate for real?

Will they participate now?

Adds to realism

- Secondary participants as necessary






Planning

Set deadlines










Planning

- Willing to speak up






Execution

Evaluators

- Knowledgable
- Willing to <u>NOT</u> speak up








Execution

Remain Flexible

Plan for the unexpected Don't stray too far from plan





Evaluation

Capture Everything


Players logs

Evaluator notes

Controller notes

Player debriefs







Evaluation

Let the players critique themselves

- Often more harsh on themselves
- Usually accurate
- They have more buy in to final evaluation



Evaluation

When the evaluation is complete

Have a plan for what to do with the findings

Meet your counterparts

Better to meet at an exercise than at the real thing

Great time to validate plans

Test new ideas

Evaluate new technologies
