Cruise Industry Economy Impact

(Based on 2006)

- Total cruise port visits in 2006 – 1.7 million
(increase of 200,000 over 2003)
- Cruise indirect & direct spending \$1.1 billion
- Total economic impact \$2.2 billion
- Total employment generated 16,000 jobs
- Taxes generated \$190 million
(indirect business & income tax)
