Facilities

Facilities

- TWIC Compliance for Owners and Operators of Maritime Transportation Security Act (MTSA) regulated facilities will be phased in based on Captain Of The Port (COTP) zones leading up to the National Compliance Date of 15 April 2009.
- TWIC Final Rule, published on January 25, 2007, advises Owners and Operators of MTSA regulated facilities of their responsibility to notify employees of the TWIC requirements. Specifically, 33 CFR 105.200(b)(14) require owners or operators of MTSA regulated facilities to "[i]nform facility personnel of their responsibility to apply for and maintain a TWIC, including the deadlines and methods for such applications.

Vessels & Mariners





- ► MTSA regulated Vessel Owners and Operators must comply with TWIC no later than 15 April 2009.
- Coast Guard Credentialed Mariners
 - ► Mariners must obtain TWICs prior to 15 April 2009.
 - Mariners may use their valid Coast Guard-issued MMD, License or COR, along with a valid photo ID, to be eligible for unescorted access in secure areas of any MTSA-regulated facility that has a compliance date earlier than April 15, 2009.

Enforcement

- TWIC verifications will be incorporated into MTSA inspections. Failure to comply with the regulations set forth in MTSA can result in both criminal and civil penalties and various control and compliance measures of facilities and vessels not in compliance. The CG will conduct:
 - ➤ Announced One announced Annual Compliance exam within each calendar year;
 - ➤ Unannounced At least one unannounced Facility Security Spot Check for each facility within each calendar year; and
 - ➤ Unannounced where warranted An unannounced MTSA Annual Compliance Examination where the Facility Security Spot Check or deficiency history warrants.
