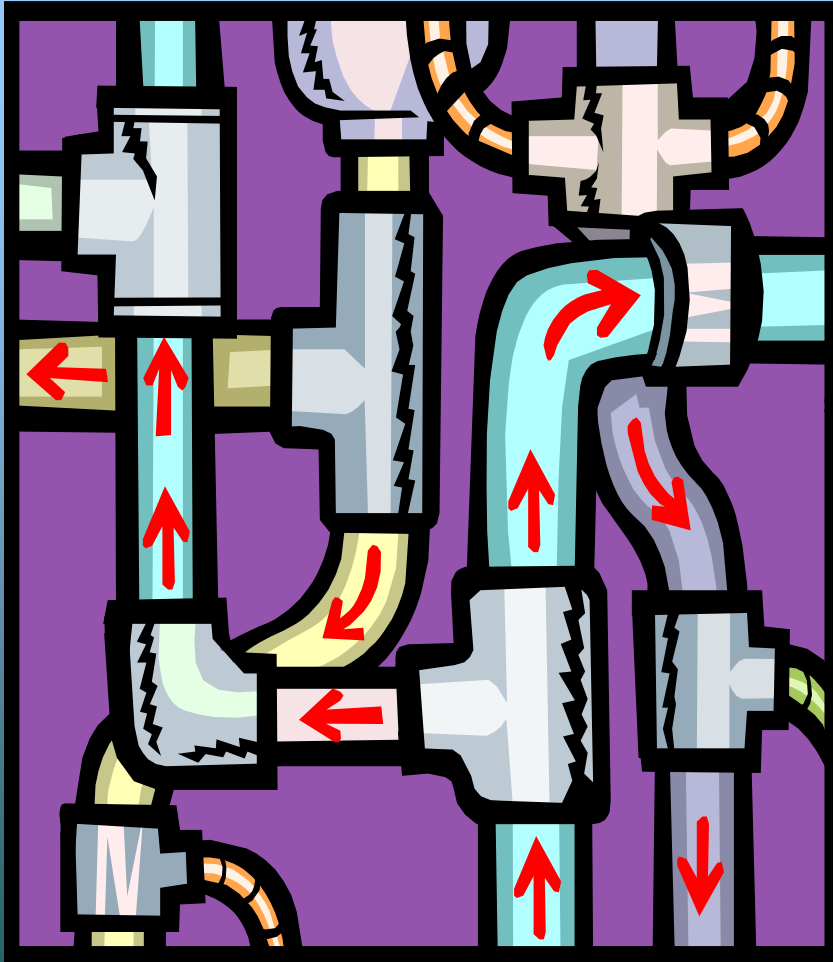

- ❑ Best use of scarce capital

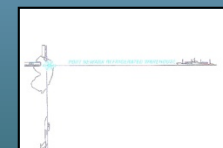
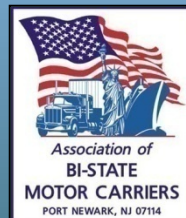

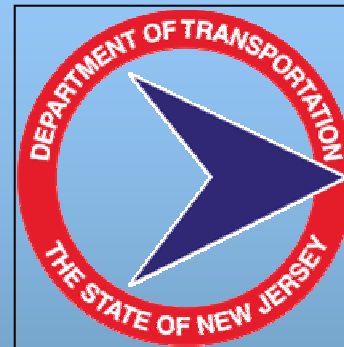
