# Trade Corridors Improvement Fund: Background

- Trade Corridors Improvement Fund (TCIF)
  - \$2 Billion Statewide
  - Focus on infrastructure improvements on high volume trade corridors
- Eligible Projects:
  - Highway and freight rail system access improvements
  - Enhancements to seaport capacity
  - U.S.-Mexico border access projects to improve freight movements
- SANDAG and Port of San Diego collaborated to secure TCIF funding for Port Access Improvements
