The first challenge was dealing with the influx of media.



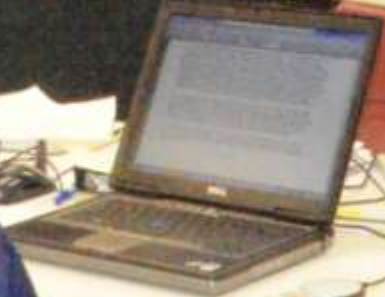








Another challenge was establishing the Incident Command/ EOC at our Police Operations Center.
