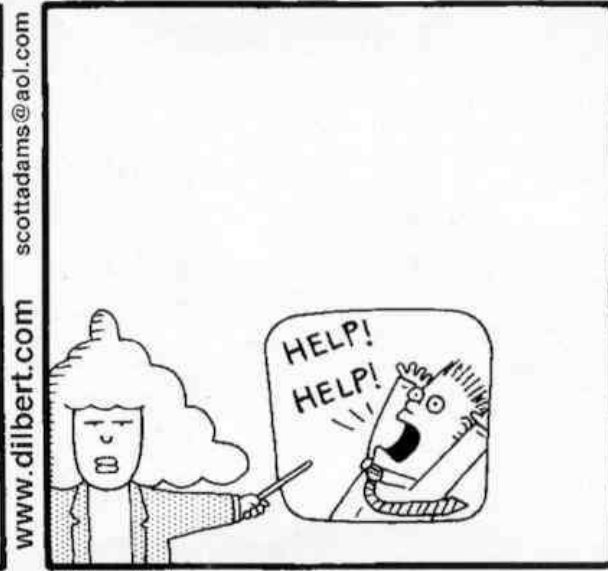

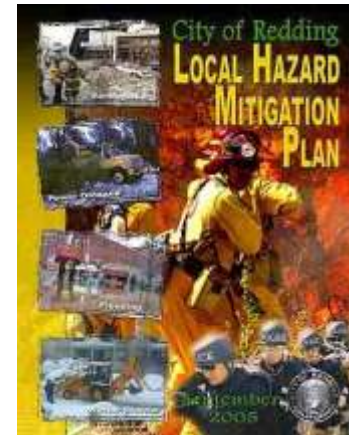
Recovery

 - For Port Community

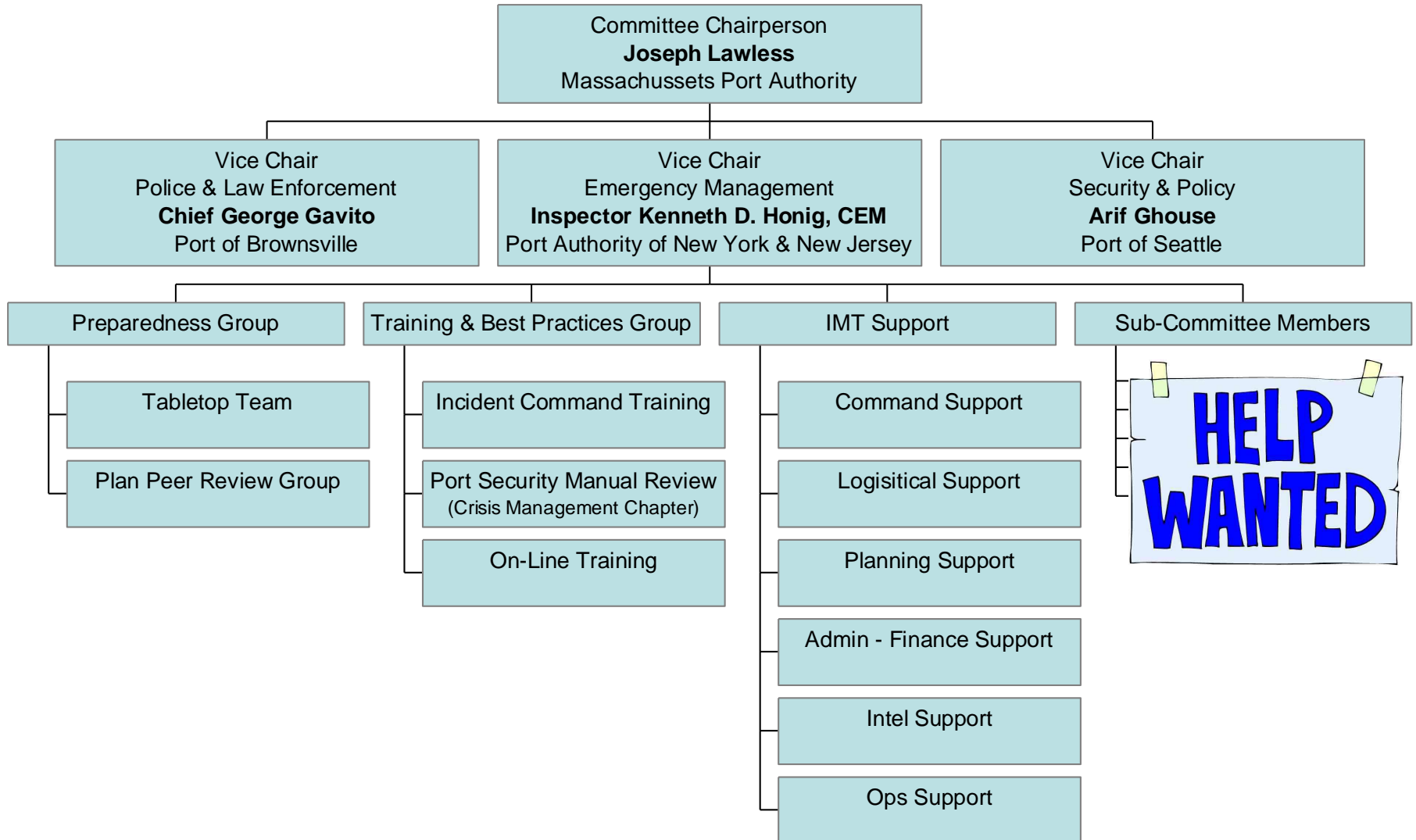


Mitigation

- Steps taken to reduce the impact of a disaster, attack or stoppage on port clients, customers and the port community



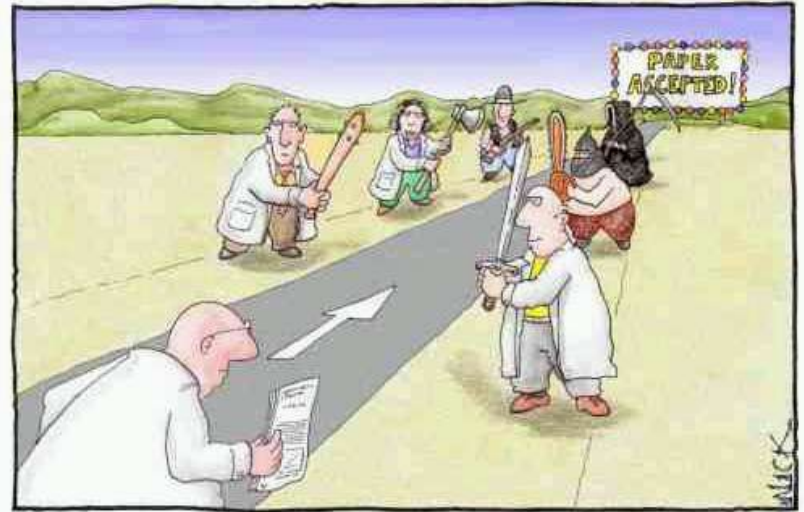

 - Technical Specialists

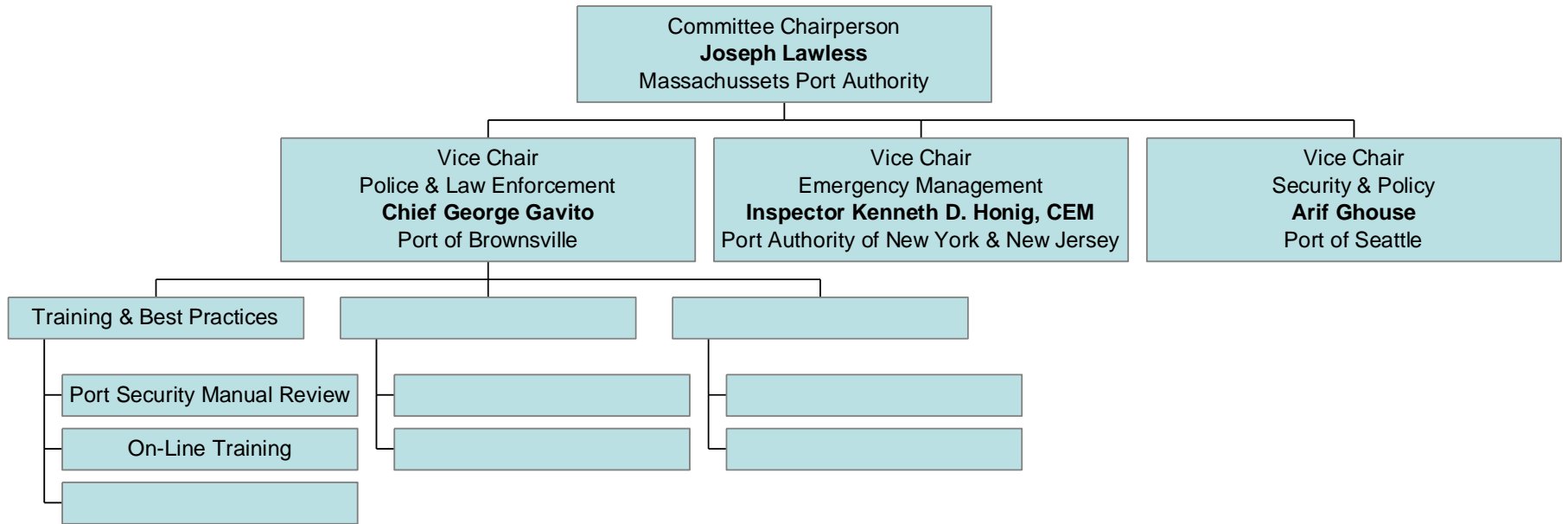

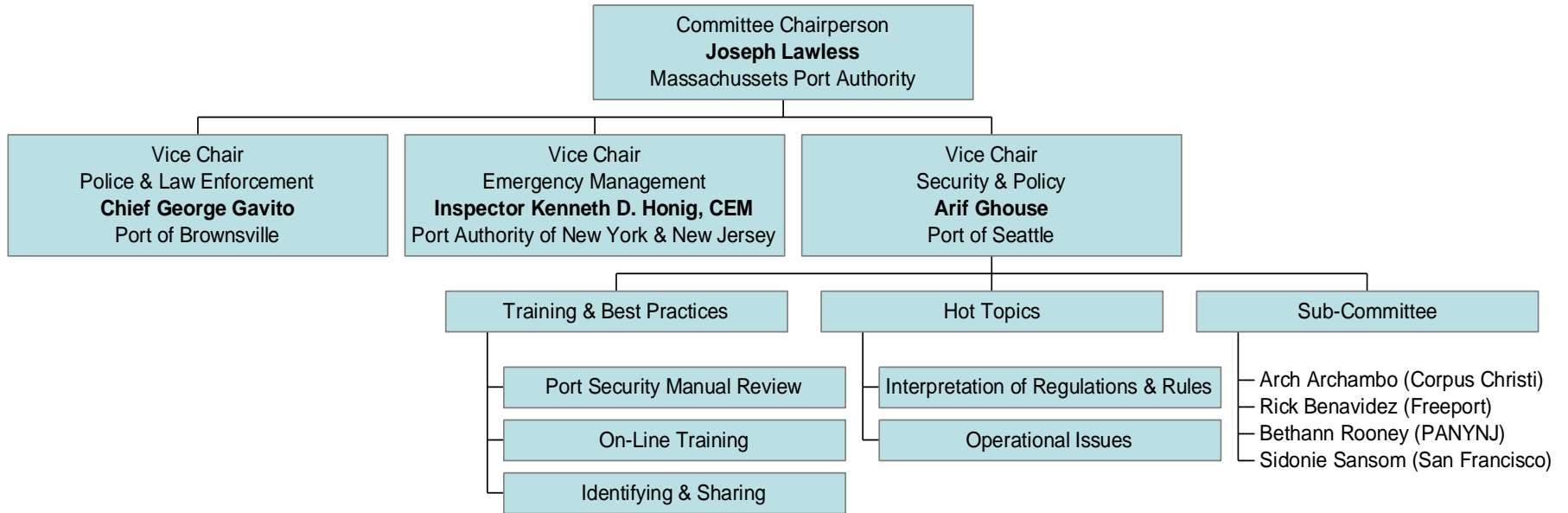
