The Port of Saint John, the largest seaport in the Province of New Brunswick, Canada handles an average of 27 million metric tonnes of cargo annually. Centrally located in Atlantic Canada and only 100 Kilometers (60 miles) from the United States border, the Port of Saint John is one of Canada's key ports recognized for its strategic importance to the nation's trade and economy, being the closest Atlantic Canada's port to North American consumer markets and industrial centres.
