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Transportation Worker Identification Credential

361 ports

- Over 3,200 facilities
- Over 14,000 vessels

Three elements of a TWIC compliance check:

- Verification Individuals are who they say they are
- Authentication Card is legitimate and official
- Validation Card has not expired or been revoked

- A violation of 18 USC 1028 or 18 USC 1036 may result in criminal liability in the form of a fine and/or imprisonment of not more than 30 years, depending on the facts of the case, including whether the offense is committed with intent.
