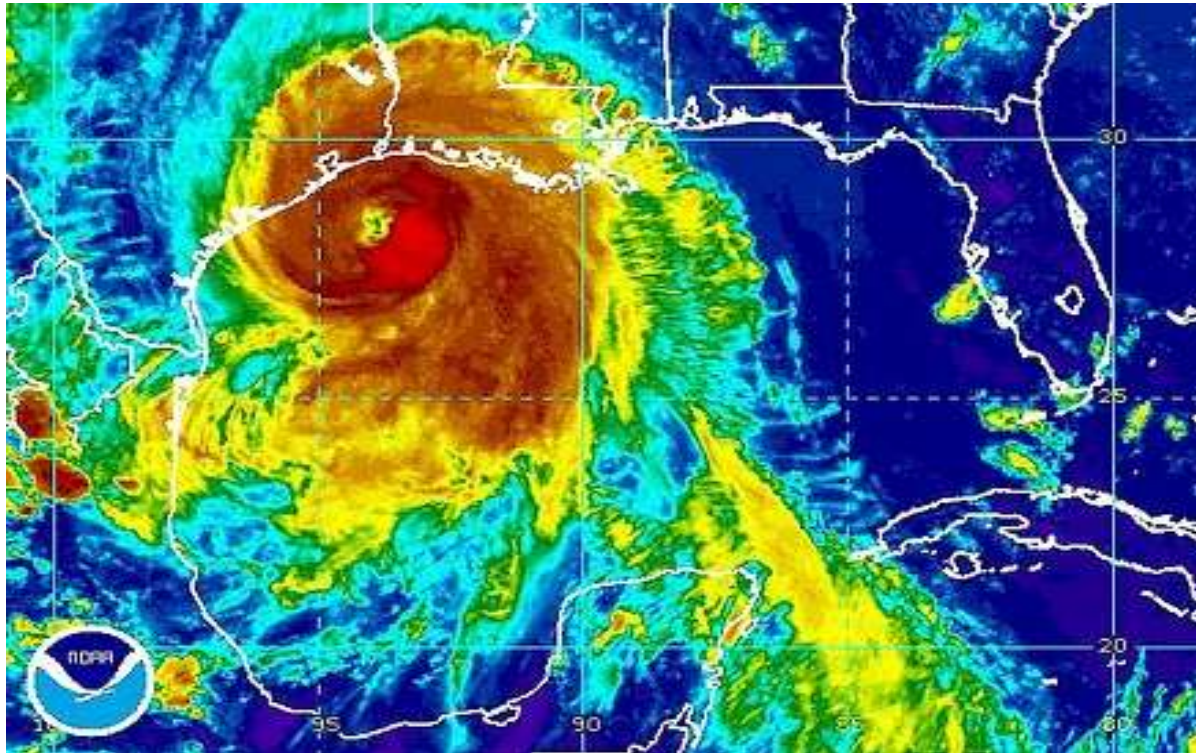

Aftermath of Hurricane Ike



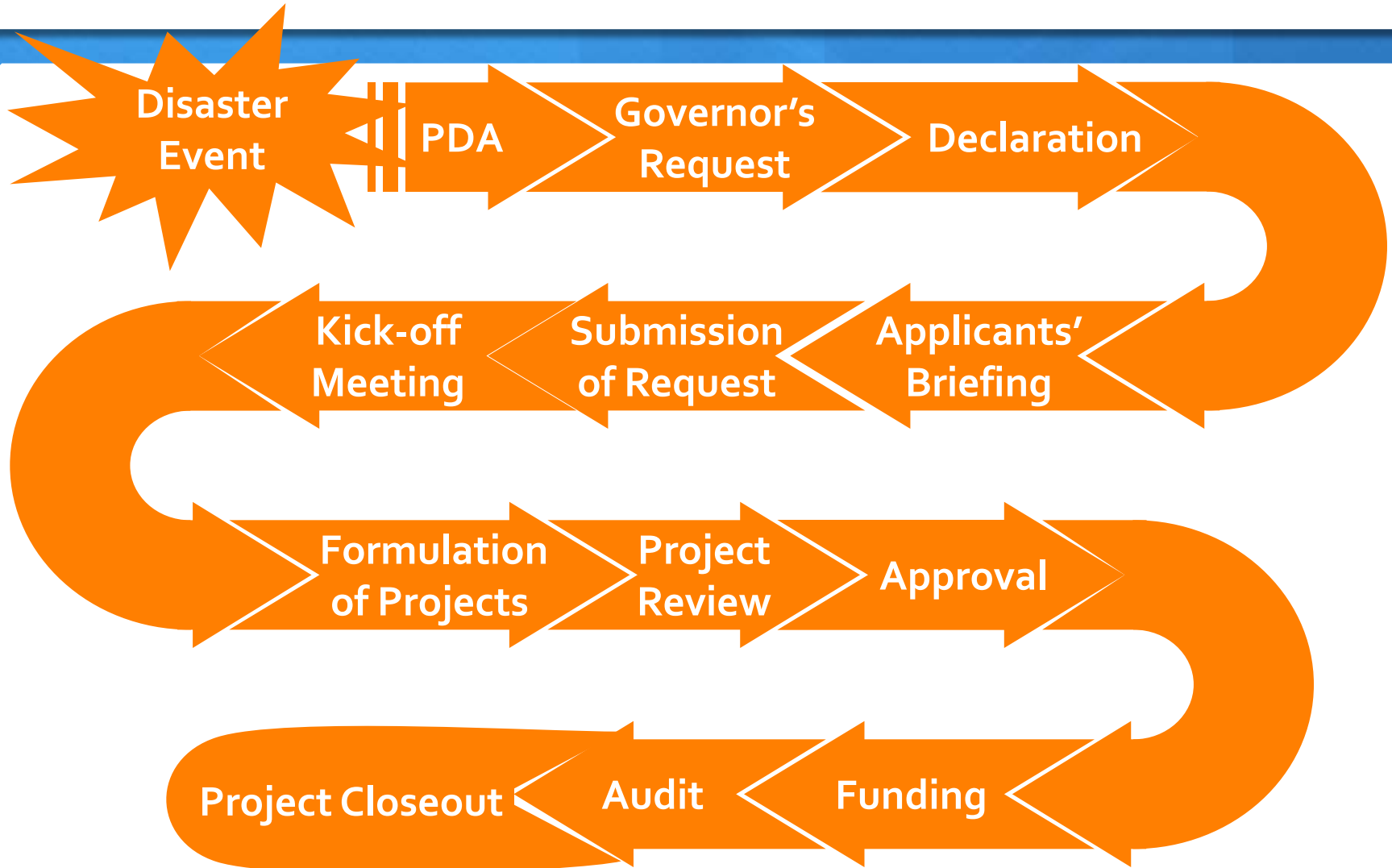

Storm Induced Erosion



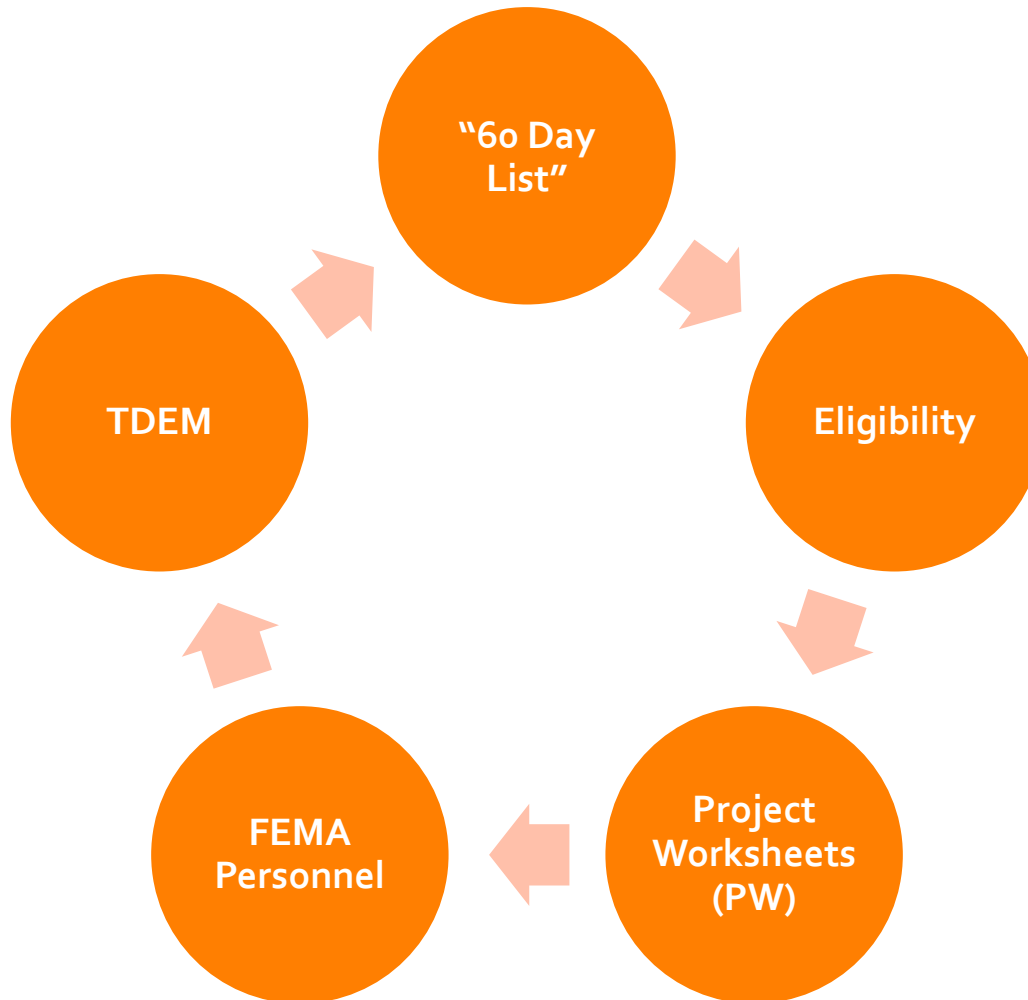
- Effect of Storm Surge

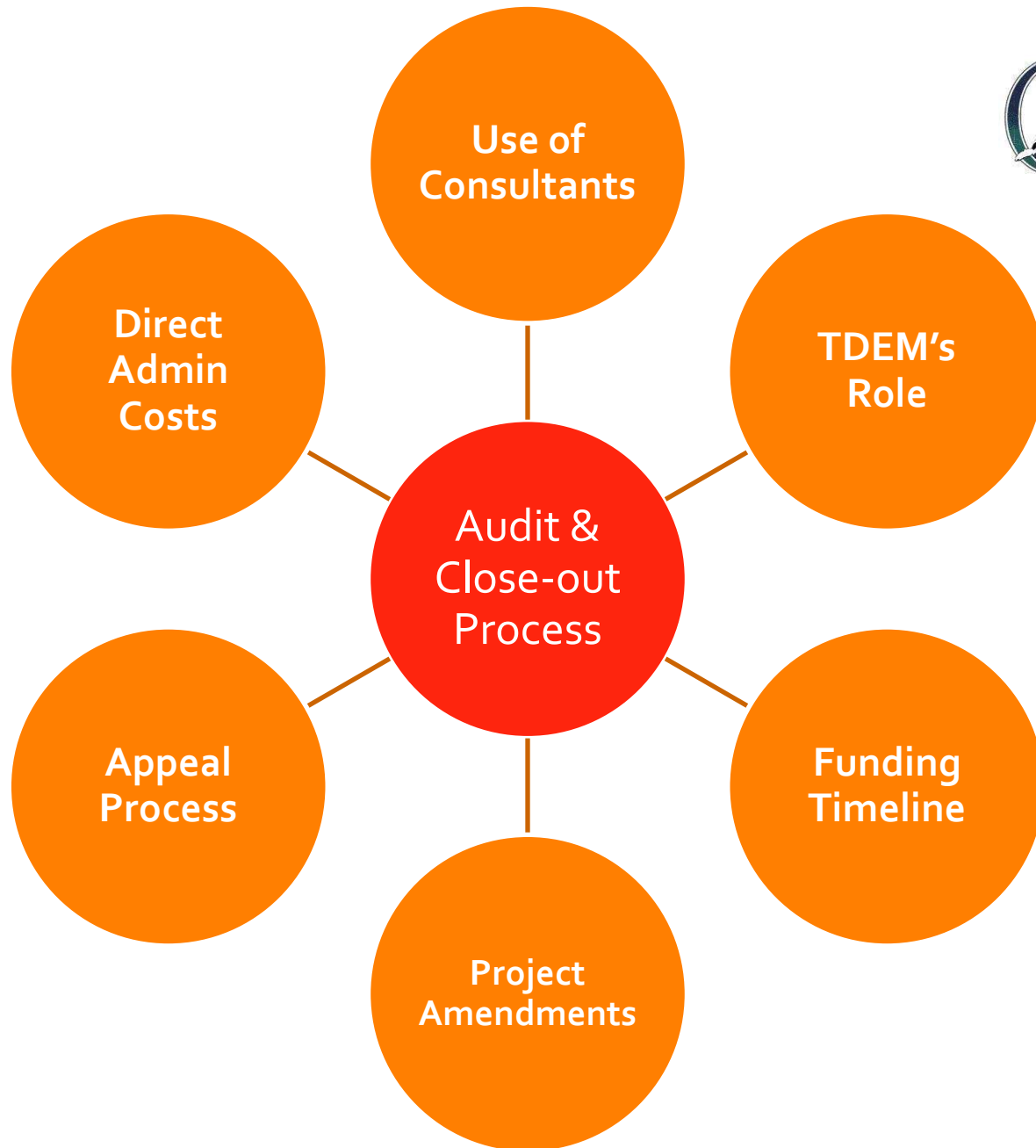
