



SFPR - Scope

- 37 km in length, four-lane expressway
- Connections to Routes 1, 15, 91, 99
- Connection to major river crossings
- Connections to port and rail facilities
- Elimination of at-grade rail crossings
- Connections to local cycling networks



SFPR - Cost

- Budget \$1.264 Billion
- Federal contribution \$365 million



Schedule

- 2008 2010 Preloading soft soil areas
 - Utility relocations
- 2010 2014 Concessionaire
 - Final design/construction
- Dec 2012 Phase 1 complete
- Dec 2013 Project complete
- 2014 2034 Concessionaire
 - 20 years operations


