




Growth in Transshipment








The Pacific Triangle Panama is key







In 2011, 86% of Panama's container traffic was transshipment





Panama's Pacific Coast has gained share....






- The Pacific coast of Panama has shown faster growth than the Atlantic coast in terms of transshipment

- The transshipment system in the Panama Pacific area is near collapse









Final: Quay 2,081 m; 27 STS; 3.9M TEU; 99 ha of CY


