






Peruvian Agricultural Scope

- Largest exporter of avocados to Europe, surpassed Chile in 2010.
- Around 10,000 young Hass Avocado hectares for exports. 100,000 MT. 1/3 of total capacity.
- 3 years to surpassing Chile in grapes exports.

 - Board members: 5 of 8 members are independent.




