



World real GDP at market exchange rates






World merchandise imports









World merchandise exports






Real GDP growth






Real GDP growth, OECD and BRICS






World real GDP and world trade volume growth





GDP based on PPP valuation







Growth in the U.S. has rebounded with jobs picking up; Japan's recovery has slowed






Euro Area

Emerging markets are adjusting to slower growth to different degrees in the region




Growth in the Middle East has been marked down; Africa is still doing well, although Ebola poses risks




World GDP in current USD

GDP by G-7, BRICS and Other World, 1960-2013 (USD)






G-7 GDP in current USD






BRICS GDP in current USD






EU, US, China and Japan GDP in current USD






Share of World GDP, 2003












Country Shares of World GDP, 2003






GDP by Country, 2003-2013






United States merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)

Graph 1: Total merchandise trade, by value






United States merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)




United States services trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)

China merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)






China merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






Canada merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)

Canada merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)



Graph 1: Total merchandise trade, by value




Mexico merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






Germany merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)

Graph 1: Total merchandise trade, by value




Germany merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






France merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)


France merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)




United Kingdom merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






Italy merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)




Italy merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)

Graph 1: Total merchandise trade, by value






Japan merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






Brazil merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)


Brazil merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






Russian Federation, merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)

Graph 1: Total merchandise trade, by value




Russian Federation merchandise trade by region (USD billions)




India merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)

India merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)




South Africa merchandise trade, 2000-2013 (USD billions)


South Africa merchandise trade by region, 2013 (USD billions)






Exports of manufactured goods, fuel and mining and agricultural products (USD billions)






Leading merchandise traders, exports vs. imports, 2013 (USD billions)






World surface transportation routes



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




U.S. intermodal and interstate highway corridors






Routes from Northeast Asia to Major North American destinations




Containership fleet by teu capacity, 2013-2014 ('000 teu)










Northern Sea Route vs. Southern Sea Route via Suez






