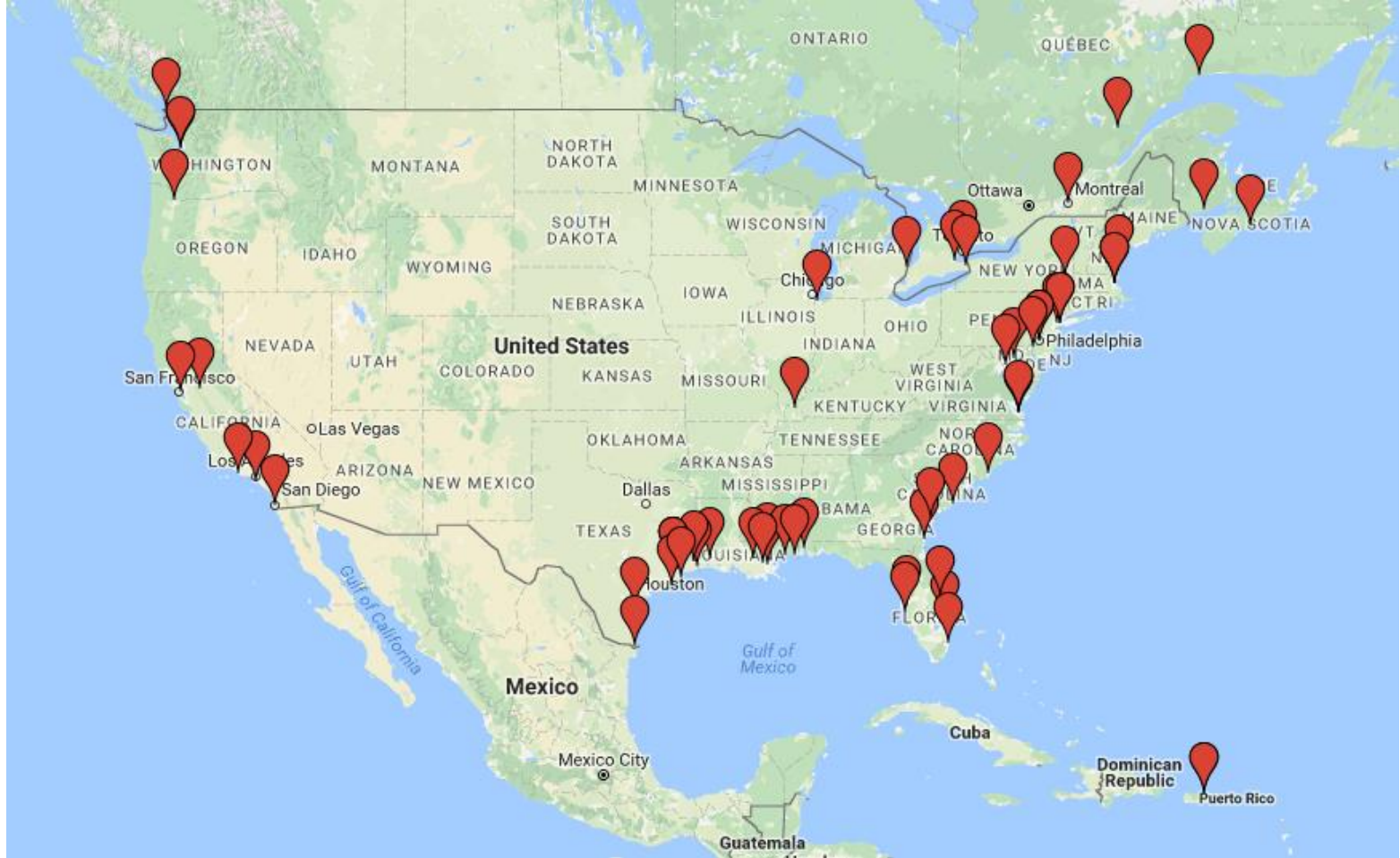

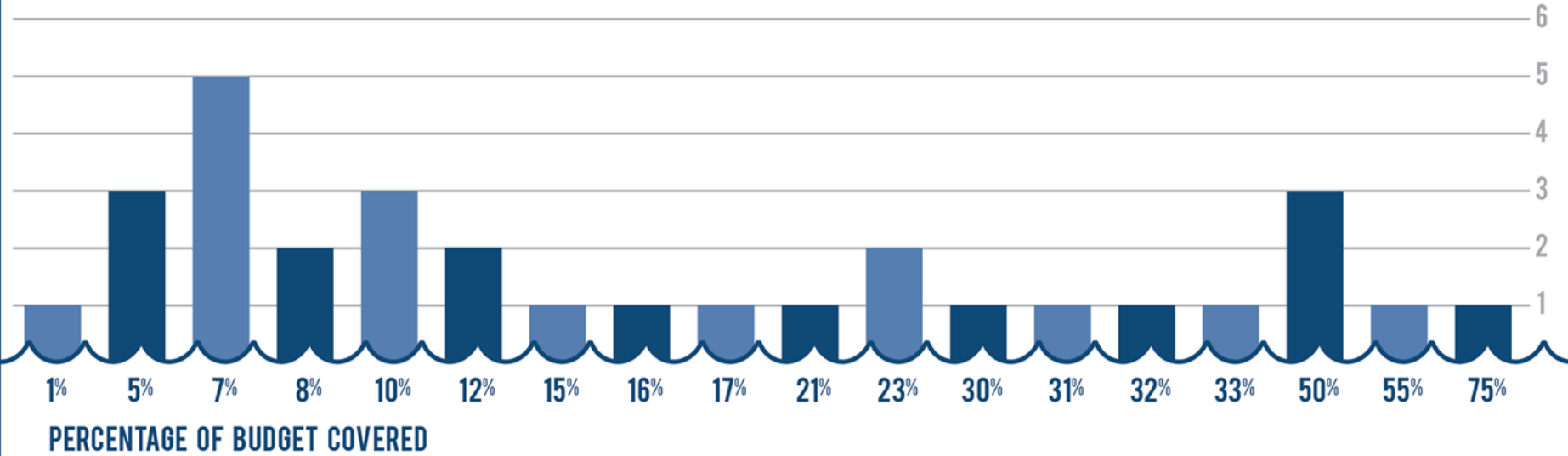

AVERAGE: 21%

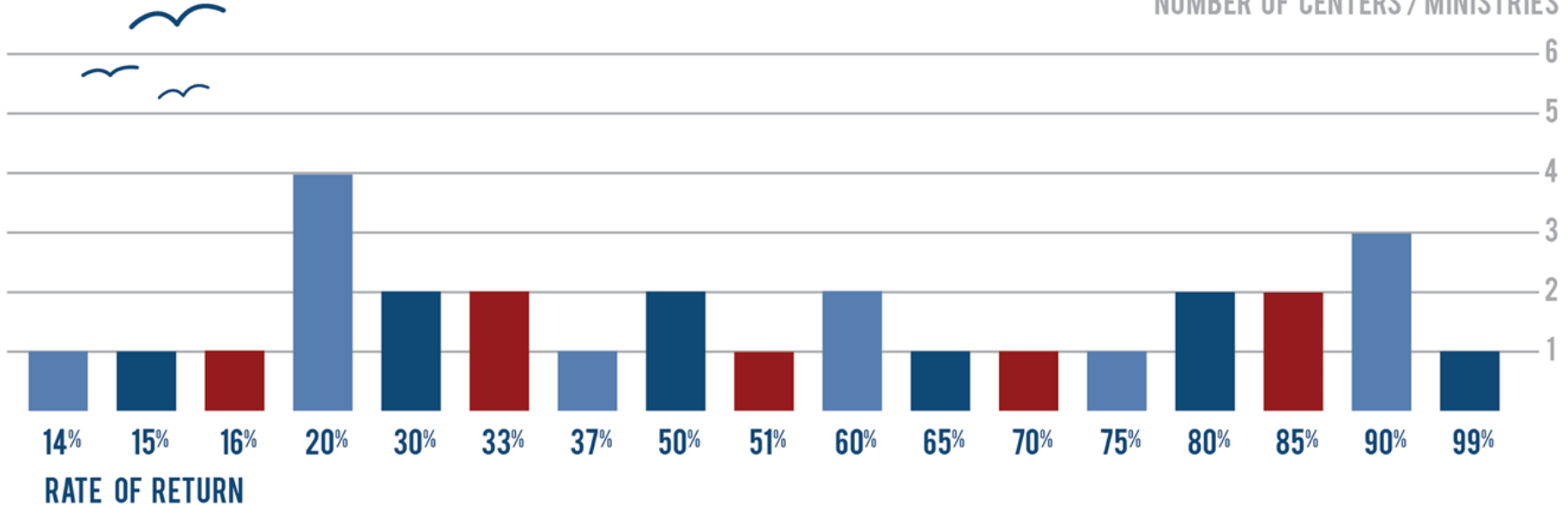

MEDIAN: 50.5%

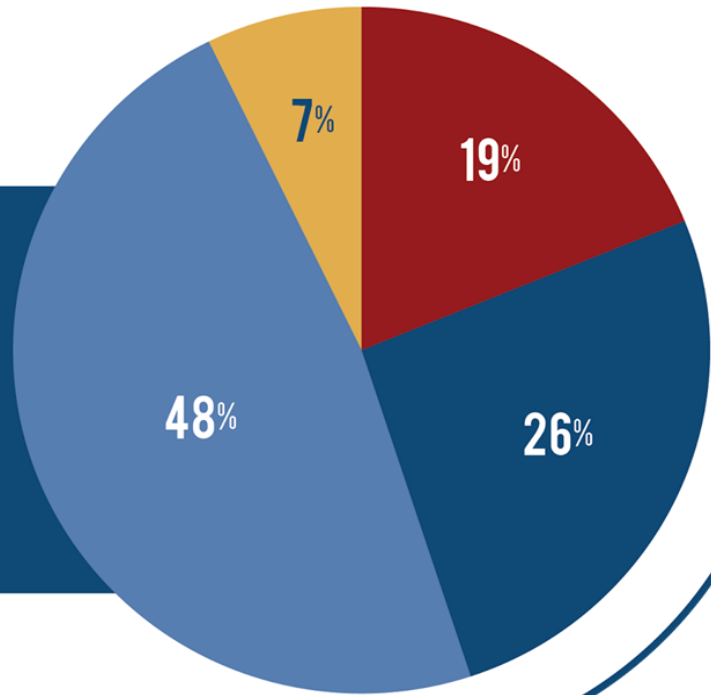
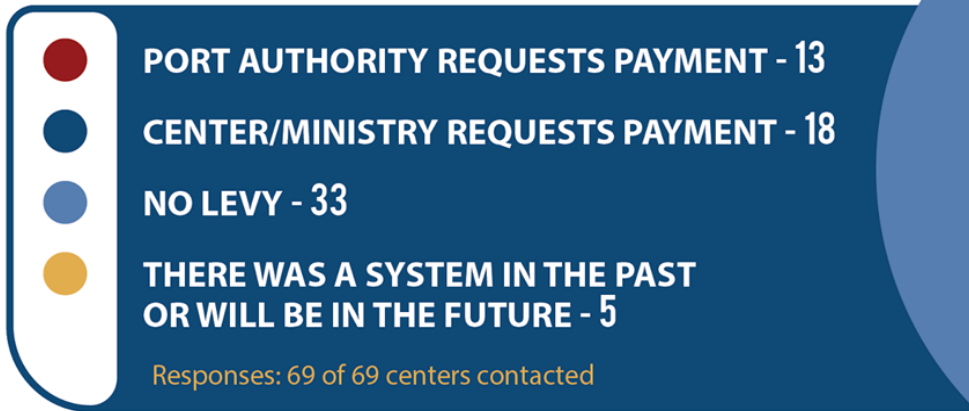

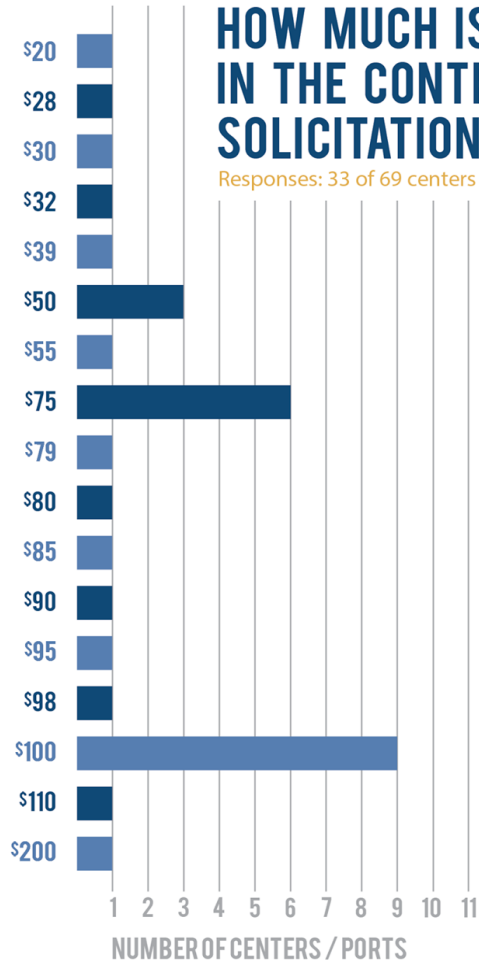
DOES YOUR PORT HAVE A SYSTEM TO COLLECT SEAFARERS' WELFARE CONTRIBUTIONS?

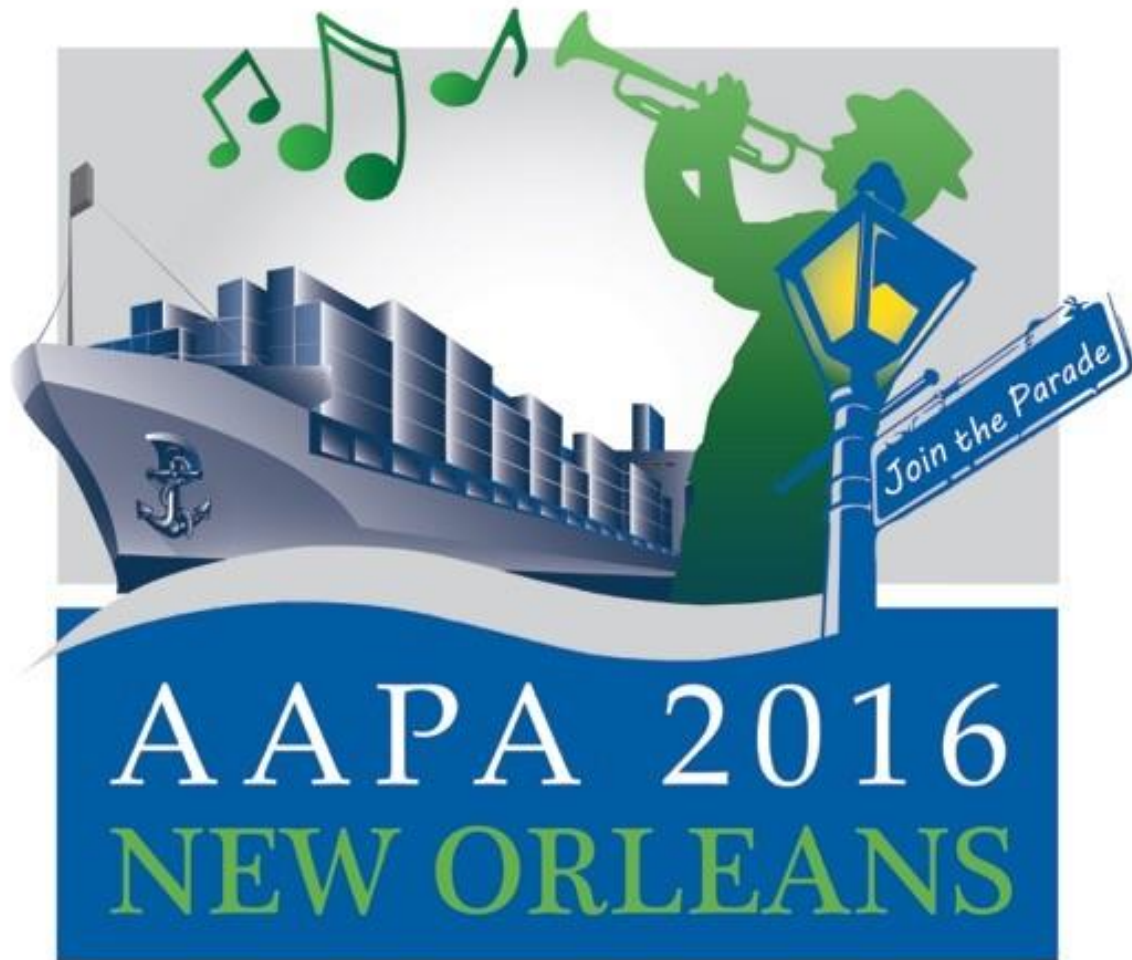
