Where We Are

- *Congress passed a \$1.15 trillion omnibus spending bill earlier this month,*
- *Includes \$100 million for the PSGP, and*
- *There will be a condensed and expedited schedule for the port security grant program.*

Port Security Grant Program Recap

- On average, Congress has been funding the PSGP at \$100 million per year.
- In FY 2016, AAPA members received over \$27 million in grant funding.
- AAPA priorities are increased funding and more direct funding to port authorities.
