- Published an in-depth data quality review
- Developing reports to link data from budget to execution







# Why rank a Full Mission package above a Partial Mission package?

#### Possible scenarios:

- A project has been historically <u>under</u>funded compared to similar projects
- A project has been historically <u>over</u>funded compared to similar projects
- A new or increased requirement due to a court order or new guidance

#### **DESIRED FUTURE STATE**

- Cross-business line application a fully integrated budget
- Better linkage to mission performance outputs
- More objective (consistent, transparent, repeatable)
- Improved understanding and justification of budget decisions
- Work packages formulated with enterprise consistency to allow comparison and prioritization
- Tracking of budget proposal through execution

### **ONGOING WORK**

- Tools that allow managers to link budget to execution
- Lifecycle portfolio management
- Operational risk tools for all business lines and all assets
- USACE value model
- Maintenance management tools that will inform Common O&M maintenance needs
- Transition O&M 20/20 sustainment and refinement efforts to Asset Management

Continue to improve O&M 20/20 based on lessons learned
