The TIGER Program created under the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA) is a \$1.5 billion dollar multi-modal discretionary grant program that was designed to provide support for innovative transportation projects of National, regional, and local significance, including projects that are often difficult to fund under the traditional transportation programs. The program received over 1400 applications, totaling almost \$60 billion and awarded 51 projects.

The purpose of this seminar is to identify the key elements of competitive applications, provide information on developing benefit cost analysis and present information on the program's processes. Additionally, the Department has received \$600m for TIGER II and information outlining this next round of grant awards will be presented.

This free seminar will be held in the Atrium of the West Building of the Department's Headquarters, as well as, simulcast via the web. Access to this webcast will be available through the Department's website at www.dot.gov.
