# RESCUE AT SEA

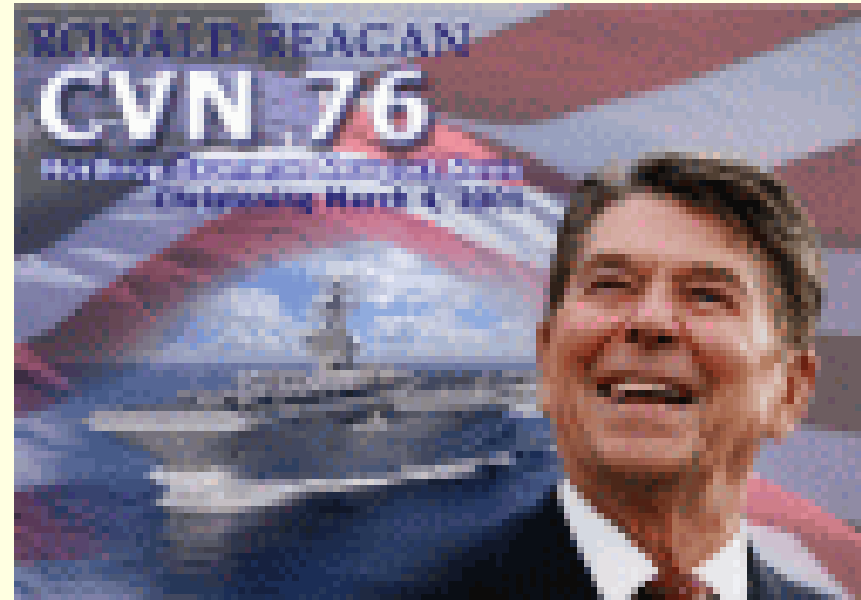
- On the evening of 14 Dec, MV Dawn Princess issued a distress call to the USCG for a medical emergency.
- USS Ronald Reagan was conducting training exercises approx 550 miles away.
- Once the Reagan closed within 175 miles they launched a helicopter to assist.
- Since the helo could not land they had to lower a basket to raise 14 y/o girl into the helo for transport back to USS Reagan.
- Helo returned to the Reagan where doctors performed an emergency appendectomy.

- Emergency Response Mutual Diving Support – Explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) and detection of explosive objects in the Port of San Diego.
